WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Resaca, Georigiain the process of preparing and adopting a zoning ordinance, the Town currently being without any laund use zoningordinance any sort and

WHEREAS, as it becomes known the Town interning to adopt zoning, property owners could rush to pull permits and commence construction on unwanted, undesirable or incompatible uses in order to vest their rightend therefore, the town desires to prevent any issuance of building permits, other than for sirightenily residences, which use is compatible with the existing pattern of development of the Town, while the process of drafting a zoning ordinance, having publibearings, and adopting the zoning ordinance proceeds; and

WHEREAS, the Georgia Supreme Court has authorized the adoption of emergency moratoriums in order to preserve the status quo while ordinances are amended and adopted; and the Town seeks to aments code of ordinances to adopt a zoning ordinance, to regulate the uses of land within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town previously adopted a moratorium on February 12,,201d3 subsequently contracted with the Northwest Georgia Regional Comm(NSCRC) to draft its zoning ordinance and the Town previously extended the moratorium eluto the NGRC not having completed its work and presented traft zoning ordinance for the TownÕs consideration; and

WHEREAS, the NGRC completed its work and theown has adopted a Zoning Ordinance on July 8, 2014 to be effective December 31, 2014, such delay to give the citizens of the Town the time to get used to the ordinance and adaptatodit

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined it is in the best interests of utbliec p health, safety and welfare textend the moratorium during such periodorder to preserve the status quoand thereby adopts following moratorium ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RESACA, GEORGIA ORDAINS, and it is heby ordained, pursuant to its Home Rule authority under the Georgia Constitution and the powers granted the Town in its Characterithe Town Council hereby establishes moratorium on the issuance of building permits for any use other than singlefamily homes, to last until December 3,12014 the effective date of the Resaca Zoning Ordinance adopted July 8, 2012 uring such time period, Gordon County shall not issue any building permitsnor accept any applications for building permits any use in the Town of Resaca except for singlemily homes. Any such permit issued, and any such application
